Responsibilities:

- Ensures the safe handling, administration and disposal of chemotherapy drugs, monitoring chemotherapy patients continually during and after treatment
- Ensures efficient and appropriate scheduling of patient chemotherapy appointments
- Proficient in the prevention and management of adverse treatment reactions
- Documentation of all procedures and activities pertaining to chemotherapy administration, accurately and efficiently, including daily patient statistics
- Provision of psychosocial support for patient and family members during treatment, including patient orientation and education
- Management of consumable stock and supplies for the chemotherapy department
- Management of patient authorisations and fees for service
- Interpretation and analysis of test results and other medical information as necessary
- Ability to work independently
- Demonstrates evidence of effective planning and organisational skills including awareness of resource management
- Demonstrates ability to manage deadlines and effectively handle multiple tasks
- Demonstrates leadership skills, including the ability to work with multi-disciplinary team members.

- Minimum 5 years post-basic clinical experience, recent clinical experience
